




# Easy Definition

# Why is Web3 so Unique?

- We have a shared core value: Decentralization.
- Shared value -> Community
- Try find one for web2!







### Small Conclusion

- Web3 to me is a community that holds the same believe:
  - Privacy is a human right
  - We can democratize finance
  - World can be better and fairer with decentralized applications
  - o ...
- Web3 is not an "industry", but a community
  - How would that change job market?

# When Joining Opyn...


- I already knew the founders for 3 months
- I built a frontend (opyn-monitor) that drives 60% of traffic
- I built a smart contract for exercisers

2 hour cultural interview

# When Joining Lyra...

- I already knew one of the founders for 1.5 years
- I built a secret project with one of their devs for 6 months
- I met the founders at ETHCC and pitched them about Grappa integration

No interview



# Compared to Web2 Tech Companies

- All my works are Open Sourced
- (Possible to) work with the team before applying

- Inbounds from Twitter / Github not LinkedIn
- Almost no interview
  - No leetcode



# Getting Hired in Web3

Just like in a traditional job market, you need weak ties

### The power of weak ties in gaining new employment

# Getting your Weak Ties

- Web3 has the easiest ways to build "connection" (weak ties)
  - By being in their Discord chat
  - By shitposting on twitter
  - By participating in Hackathon
  - By contribute to open source projects (+ build profile)
  - o It's all on the internet
- Plus: Web3 has a shared value
  - Shared value == easier to connect

# Compared to "Job Market"

- If you're in the web3 community...
  - you're already in a community
  - 類似傳統定義裡的:校友會, EMBA, 新創社團, 籃球隊?
- 比起傳統軟體業、金融業,要建立 connection 更容易

### Get Started...

#### Just

- Find a random DeFi / ZK / open source project
- Read their whitepaper
- You can usually learn from the author directly on tg / twitter
- Ask "How can i contribute?"
- Within 3 months, you're better than 90% of the "applicants" from their HR team

#### But I'm not a dev

- You can still be technical
- Understand the mechanism, understand the risk, economic model ...etc

# Working & Surviving in Web3

# Web3 is free

- Remote by nature
- Nomadding can be an option
- Lots of side projects going on
- Retreats / conference (traveling)

### Web3 is New

- You don't have a mentor, rely on community to learn something new
- Lots of direct integration with new projects
- The whole industry is rapidly changing

# Harsh truth about Web3 participants

- Users
- Founders
- Engineers

Web3 是個各種角色都充滿多樣性的產業

#### Users...

- Group 1: Cares about profit, and only profit
  - o (70%)
  - Here to make friends + money
  - From stupid users to giga brains
- Group 2: Normal user:
  - Using a real product for real reason
  - o (10%)
- Group 3: Cares about Censorship (Liberalism) / Decentralization
  - o (10%)
  - Early believer in crypto / liberalism background like cyber security community
  - Here to learn / try
- Group 4: Cares about Privacy
  - (20%) overlaps a lot with Group 3
  - Anonymous

# Developers...

- Group1: Developers working their day jobs
  - o (50%)
  - Work hard play hard, work-life-balance ...
  - Just like devs in big tech companies
- Group2: Pure Tech Nerds / Open source maxi
  - o (30%)
  - Just want to solve problems / build something good
  - Advocate for public good, open source
- Group3: Hardcore liberalist
  - o (10%)
  - Code is law
  - Fighting against the big guys

# Founders / team

- Startups Mindset (Entrepreneur)
  - o (40%)
  - Maximize market share
  - Only want to build products / build business, decentralization is not priority
  - Can pivot to new "value" quickly
- Real hardcore Web3 Advocates
  - o (10%)
  - Collaboration > competition
  - Build public goods
- Most:
  - Something in between
- You can tell the differences more easily in a bear market

# Knowing the breakdown

# 對我職涯有用的一些建議

- 1. 「計畫的重要性」
  - 計畫能夠讓自己比較客觀的面對一些目標,走到一半就發現其實沒那麼困難
  - 利用周圍環境或人,把自己逼往一個想去的方向(被動學習)
- 2. 「英文很重要」
  - 學好一個新的程式語言可以讓你薪水+50%, 學好英文可以讓你薪水+200%
- 3. 「想要提高自己的bargaining power, 就要建立自己的品牌。」
  - Bargaining Power: 從工作(公司)選擇你, 變成你選擇工作
  - 與其說「品牌」,不如說社群影響力
  - 影響力!= 成為自媒體、愛發表意見。而是有多少人信任
  - 寫文章是非常好的方法!
    - TEM 有獎徵稿
    - DeFi 燒酒螺 ... 已經一年沒更新了:(

# Random 建議

- 1. 記得社群媒體很危險!
- 2. 別急著賺錢、總有機會 cash out

# 結語

  - 用比「工作」更沈重但也更輕鬆的方式面對「Web3」
